

# Hurricane Harvey Relief

Here are some ways to be involved with relief work for those effected by Hurricane Harvey.

- 1) Pray: Pray for all who have been effected by this devastating storm. Pray for those who are helping them: first responders, disaster coordinators and volunteers.
- 2) Give Money: Make your check to the church with the following information on the memo line "Harvey Conference Advance 5827".
- 3) Give Needed Supplies: Supplies will be collected through September 24. Place supplies inside the altar rail at the front of the sanctuary.
  - 1) cleaning kits or hygiene kits (go to [umcor.org](http://umcor.org) and click the "relief kits" link to learn contents and packing instructions)
  - 2) box fans (to dry out houses following flooding)
  - 3) 25' heavy duty extension cords (minimum of 14 gauge, for use with box fans)
  - 4) 2 gallon sprayers (to fight mildew and mold)
  - 5) flat billed shovels (to remove mud and muck from flood damaged homes)
  - 6) 3" tine rakes (to remove leaves, limbs and muck from flood damaged homes and yards)
  - 7) two wheeled wheel barrows (to prevent overturning while carting refuse to the street)
- 4) Volunteer: Let Jeff Helmly or Brother Michael know if you would be interested in being part of a team going to area effected by Harvey when volunteers are called in to help.
